TAM 115 is a new dryland wheat with improved disease resistance and growth for grazing during winter months. TAM 115 has good early coverage. It is resistant to leaf rust, stripe rust, stem rust, green bug, and curl mite. For grain only or grazing-grain operations this variety has the resistances and drought tolerance to perform very well.
